## ACADEMICS

### Elementary School (Grades K3-5<sup>th</sup>):

The A Beka curriculum is used in all areas until Saxon Math is introduced in 4<sup>th</sup> grade.

The students have weekly enrichment classes in music, computer, and physical education and a weekly library period.

### Middle School (Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>):

Students in middle school continue with A Beka and Saxon Math. In addition to their core subjects, students have regular bible and computer classes.

### High School (Grades 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>):

High school courses, both required and elective, help students prepare for life after Central. Students choose from a variety of electives including Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, Biology I & II, Chemistry I & II,
